

Deer Lakes Boosters
Meeting Minutes
Wednesday, March 17, 2010
Call to Order - 7:11pm

NOTE: Flea Market/ Craft sale meeting occurred prior to the regular booster meeting. Since there was not enough time, this meeting continued after the booster meeting ended.

Secretary: Absent. Reading of purpose and reviewing February minutes completed by Mary Matthews.

Head Chaperone: Not present but, sent a message through Mary Matthews that all schedules were completed. Last Event for 2009-2010, Winterguard Championships, March 27, 2010.

Guard Liaison: Gift Bags complete for both MS and HS Winterguard squads. Executive board voted to give each HS/MS Winterguard participant one of the Deer Lakes Car flags. A Discussion also occurred about the resignation of Ms. Earls as Guard Director.

Treasurer: Kim Wesolek reported that there were still two HS Winterguard member's wit outstanding fees. A System needs to be created to get the fees prior to performances. Fitness Report: Student Accounts approx. \$4000, Band aid account approx \$1300. Checking account approx \$7000. Most of the money in the checking account is already scheduled to pay for the Spring Trip, Banquet, Craft Sale/Flea market, Band Picnic, Start up for Concession stand etc... Vice President: Diane Boyer had nothing new to report. All fundraising information discussed in old or new business.

President: Mary Matthews explained that all booster offices are up for re-election or election. Nomination will be accepted at the March Booster meeting and voting will occur at the April meeting. New Officers take their positions at the June Meeting.

Old Business: Car flags will remain on old business until we get rid of them. After the decision to give some of them to MS/HS Wintergurard, only 26 remain. Spring bulbs fundraiser had 10 participants and total sales of \$415.00. All profits credited to student accounts. Winterguard participation fees still outstanding as stated in the Treasurer's report above.

New Business: There were no nominations received for 2010-2011 officers. Kim Dreslinski expressed an interest in the becoming Treasurer and Betsy Bialosky the Vice President position. All current members are willing to return, if re-elected. There is no rule in the by-laws as to what to do if no one steps forward for a position. Nominations can be received

until 5 minutes prior to the April Booster Meeting. Board Members made phone calls to parents of both HS band and guard members and MS Winterguard members inviting them to attend the booster meetings. Hoagie orders for March were due on March 16, 2010 and pick up is March 22, 2010 At DLHS. Much Discussion occurred regarding the Flea Market/Craft sale. As of this date, there were 7 tables sold. The membership decided that each parent will be assigned something to donate (cookies, pop etc...) as well as \$5.00. The \$5.00 will be used to create gift baskets to raffle. Michelle Bailey will look into getting signs to advertise for the Craft/Sale Fleas Market. Cedar point trip is scheduled for Saturday, May 22, 2010. The cost is \$80.00 per student and must be paid in full by April 15, 2010. If you are delinquent, you will not be able to participate in the trip. If you want to use money from student accounts, you must contact Kim Wesolek prior to April 15, 2010. Sprint Concert is April 27, 2010 at Pine-Richland High School. Reason: The HS auditorium is under construction. Band Banquet is Sunday, June 6, 2010 at Harmar house. Mrs. Beck from the HS VisCom Department will print Band Banquet programs if given her one month prior to the banquet. Band Picnic, Friday, June 18, 2010 at Deer Lakes Park. Tentative Band Camp Dates: Last week in July, first 2 full weeks in August and the first 2 days of the third week in August with Preview Show on Wednesday and Kennywood on Thursday. More information will be distributed at the band picnic. Jim Zufall presented and fundraisers at a car show run by a friend. We can do a 50/50 raffle and obviously make some easy extra money. Jim will look into dates and get back to us. Cheryl Dauer also brought forward fundraising ideas with Cleantown Car Wash. We will investigate and get back to everyone,
