PIMBA: Deer Lakes is hosting the last PIMBA show before Championships, on 10/20/2018. The activities/fundraisers will be the same as AKV. For PIMBA, we will require judge runners. There are 15 bands signed up for attendance at PIMBA.

Warm up Areas – There will be **three** of each designated area, which will be identified as follows:

A – Pit B – General Band C – Guard/Dance

Appropriate lighting and the use of a generator will be available. *If anyone has portable lighting that they can provide for this event, we ask that you please bring it. We may or may not use it, but it would be great to have available if the need arises.

Parking – Jeremy Adamsky – We will be blocking off areas with tape for handicap guests. Due to the weather, we will not have use of the practice field for parking. We will be utilizing the High School paved parking area; the Middle School and behind bus garage; East Union School and possibly East Union Church. Individuals assisting with parking will be required to wear vests for visibility.

We are expecting approximately 43 buses and will be parking them as follows:

All buses in the front of the school; Trailers will be parked along the sides and at the front of the school; Lift-gate trucks will be parked by the loading docks. We will have signs for all schools.

The first buses are expected to roll in at approximately 2:00 PM

The National Anthem will be at 3:45 PM
